Review: Marc Brzustowski at Gallery 1313, Toronto

"Montreal artist Marc Brzustowski is an engagingly old-fashioned painter who sets up his easel in the streets just the way the French Impressionists did, and paints what he sees. The result of this rather refreshingly conventional practice is the vast number of delectable little oil panels making up his exhibition 'tabernaque attaque!' in the tiny process gallery at Gallery 1313. If I simply list their subjects – Montreal streets, Montreal canals, bridges, warehouses, churches – it's going to sound dull. But words cannot convey Brzustowski's remarkable way with light and atmosphere, his way of incarnating watery sunlight. The paintings may be traditional but they're effulgent with visual pleasure."
